

Make Your Plan to Vote!

How Can I Vote in Pennsylvania?

There are **3 WAYS** for all registered voters to cast their ballots in Pennsylvania for the General Election: (1) early in person, (2) by mail, and (3) in person on Election Day!

Early In Person

Starting this fall through **October 27 at 5:00PM**, voters in Pennsylvania can go to their [county board of elections office \(votespa.com/county\)](https://votespa.com/county) or satellite county elections offices to request and cast their ballot on site. Before you go **call your county elections office to make sure ballots are final and ready to be printed for you.**

If you need to register to vote, you can begin this process at your county elections office by registering over the counter first, and then immediately requesting a ballot. Don't forget, the deadline to register to vote is **October 19**.

By Mail

To cast your ballot by mail, voters must sign up to vote by mail either online (PADems.com/Mail) or with the [paper application](#). Your county will mail you a ballot, including prepaid return postage, which you then must complete and return. We recommend you apply ASAP to ensure you'll have enough time to receive, mark, and return your ballot. In order for your ballot to count, it must arrive at your county board of elections office or county designated dropbox no later than **8:00PM on November 3**.

In Person on Election Day

Polls will be open **7:00AM - 8:00PM on Tuesday, November 3**. Be sure to confirm your [polling location \(votespa.com/status\)](https://votespa.com/status) when making your plan to vote on Election Day.
