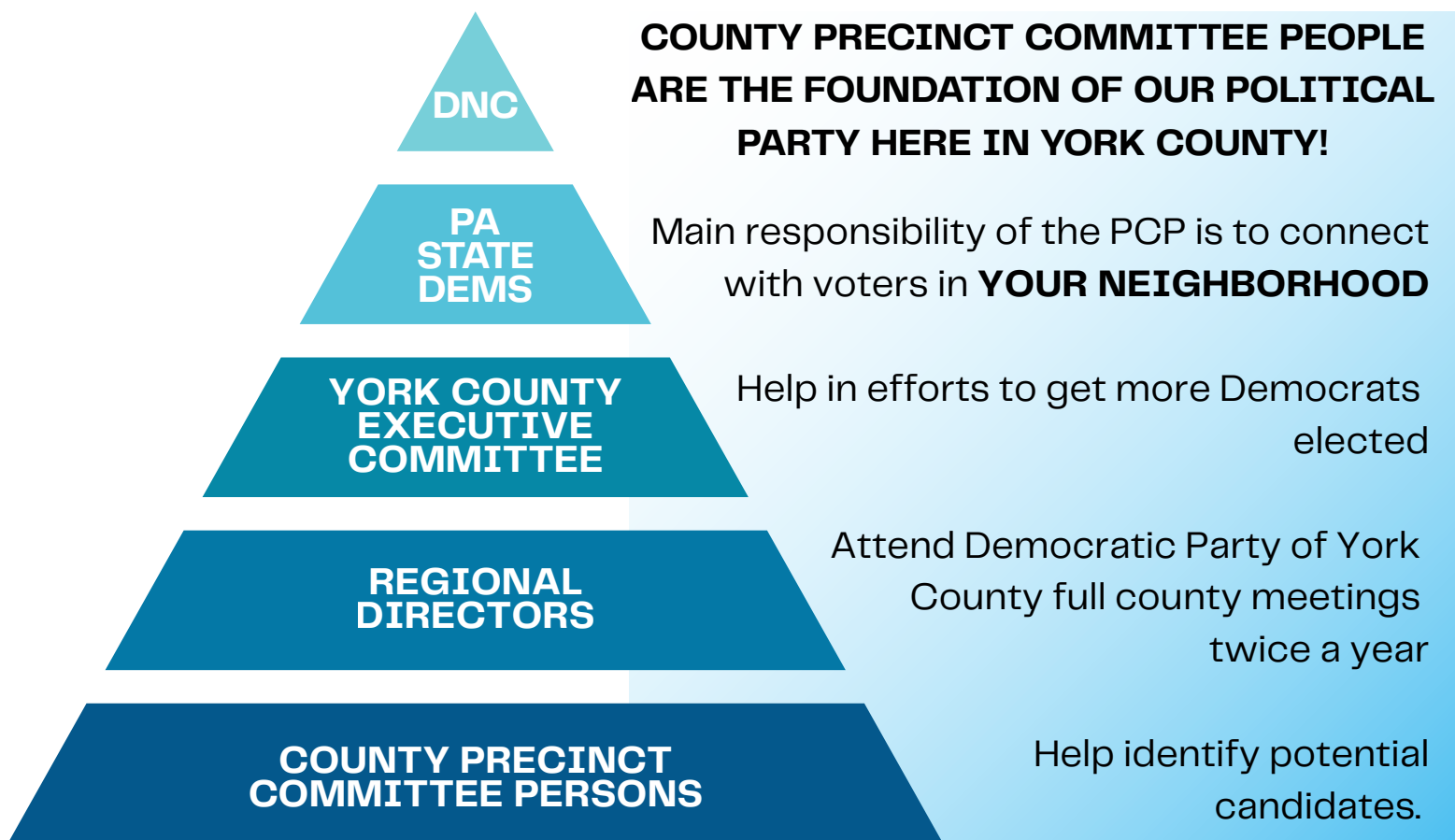


# POWERING LOCAL VOICES THROUGH PRECINCT LEADERSHIP



## BECOMING A PRECINCT COMMITTEE PERSON (PCP)

- A total of **322** committee slots throughout the county
  - York County has 161 voting precincts
  - Each party gets two (2) committee seats per precinct
- Committee people must live in the precinct and be a Democrat
- Committee members are elected during the Primary election of gubernatorial election years
  - Committee members must collect 10 petition signatures in order to appear on the Primary ballot
  - The County Chair may appoint committee members anytime after the county reorganization meeting in June of the gubernatorial election year

## PARTY REORGANIZATION IN BRIEF

- **On Primary Day of a Gubernatorial Year**
  - Elect Precinct Committee People
  - Elect State Committee members
    - 3 Women & 3 Men to represent York County on PA Democratic State Committee
- **In early June, hold York Dems Reorganization meeting**
  - all elected Precinct Committee members and State Committee members convene to elect York Dems Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer & Secretary (four-year terms)
- **Also in early June, hold PA State Dems Reorganization meeting**
  - State Committee members elected state party leadership
